### BENEFITS

#### FOOD QUALITY

- High in protein.
- Excellent resistance to baking.

#### EXPTIONAL STEM HOLD

- Not very sensitive to lodging.

### IDENTITY CARD

- ✓ **Type:** PEA BEAN
- ✓ **Registered:** France 2020
- ✓ **TWK:** 200 g to 220 g
- ✓ **Plant height:** Average
- ✓ **First pod height:** Medium
- ✓ **Grain color:** White
- ✓ **Grain Shape:** Kidney
- ✓ **Flowering:** Half late
- ✓ **Lodging:** Resistant

### CULTURE TIPS

#### PLOT SELECTION

- **Avoid hydromorphic soils:** crop sensitive to excess water and root asphyxiation.
- **Avoid acidic and sandy soils.**
- **Prefer well exposed and drained soils, of clayey-limestone type, even superficial.**

#### IMPLEMENTATION

- Soils with a pH above 7 facilitate the establishment of nodules.
- Deep tillage is recommended to facilitate the implantation of nodules.



### VERY GOOD POTENTIAL YIELD

- ✓ **Easy to harvest**
- ✓ **Grouped to flowering for harvest at maturity**



### SEEDING

- ✓ **Sowing with a precision planter is recommended**
  - **Row spacing:** 30 to 60 cm
  - **Seeding density:** 30 to 40 seeds/m<sup>2</sup>
