BENEFITS

FOOD QUALITY

- High in protein.
- Excellent baking properties.

VERY GOOD STEM HOLD

- Not very sensitive to lodging.

- ✓ **Type:** COCO
- ✓ **Registered:** France 2020
- ✓ **TWK:** 580 g to 620 g
- ✓ **Plant height:** Short
- ✓ **First pod height:** Low
- ✓ **Grain color:** White
- ✓ **Grain Shape:** Oval
- ✓ **Flowering:** Half early
- ✓ **Lodging:** Resistant

CULTURE TIPS

PLOT SELECTION

- **Avoid hydromorphic soils:** crop sensitive to excess water and root asphyxiation.
- **Avoid acidic and sandy soils.**
- **Prefer well exposed and drained soils, of clayey-limestone type, even superficial.**

IMPLEMENTATION

- Soils with a pH above 7 facilitate the establishment of nodules.
- Deep tillage is recommended to facilitate the implantation of nodules.

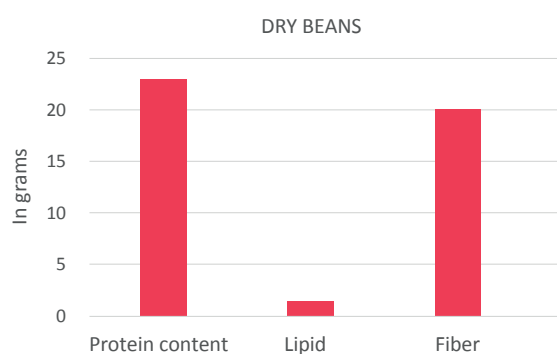


VERY GOOD POTENTIAL YIELD

SEEDING

- ✓ **Sowing with a precision planter is recommended**
 - **Row spacing:** 30 to 60 cm
 - **Seeding density:** 45 to 55 seeds/m²
