CULTURE TIPS

- Planting density should integrate all possible losses:

Water conditions	Emerged plants /ha	Planting density /ha
No irrigation / Dry	450 000	500-560 000
Irrigated / Rainy	350 000	390-440 000

- Distance between rows: 25 to 60 cm
- Planting depth: 2 to 4 cm
- Plant in warm soils (>10°C) with warm temperatures during the days after planting

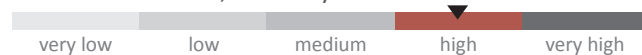

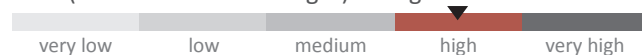
